



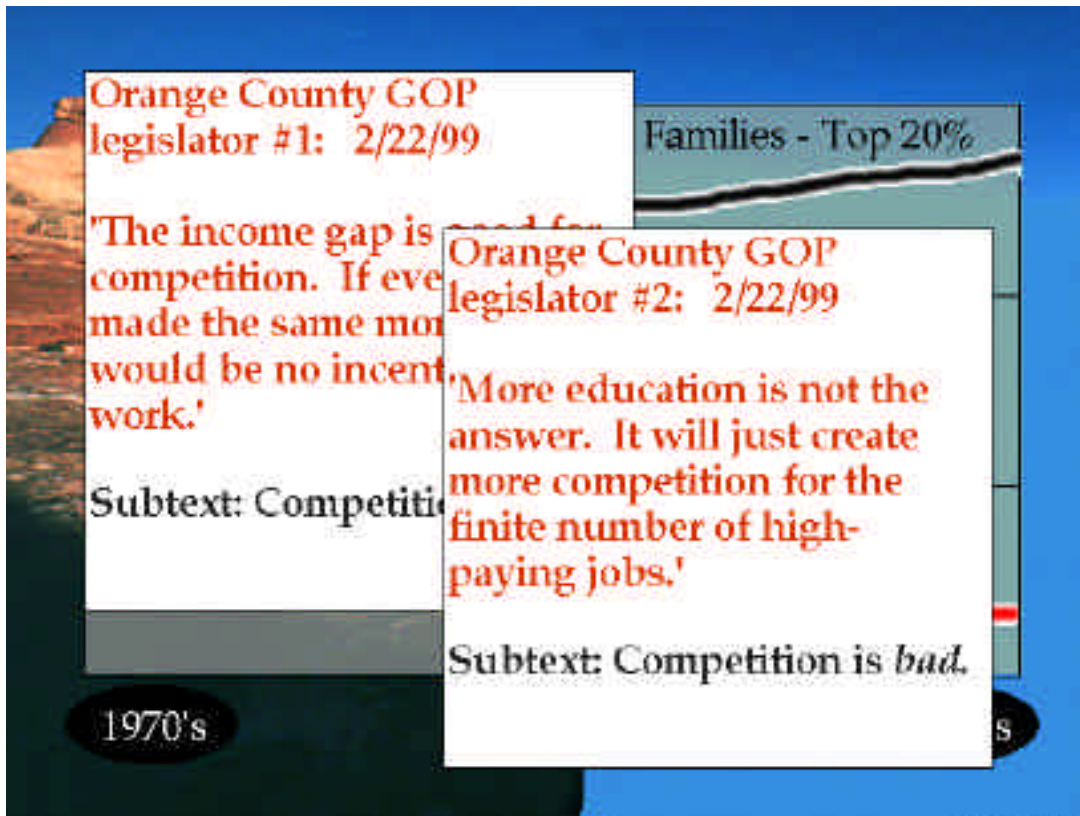
Unseen Force: Not Voting

>50% eligible (1924) turnout lowest since 1824

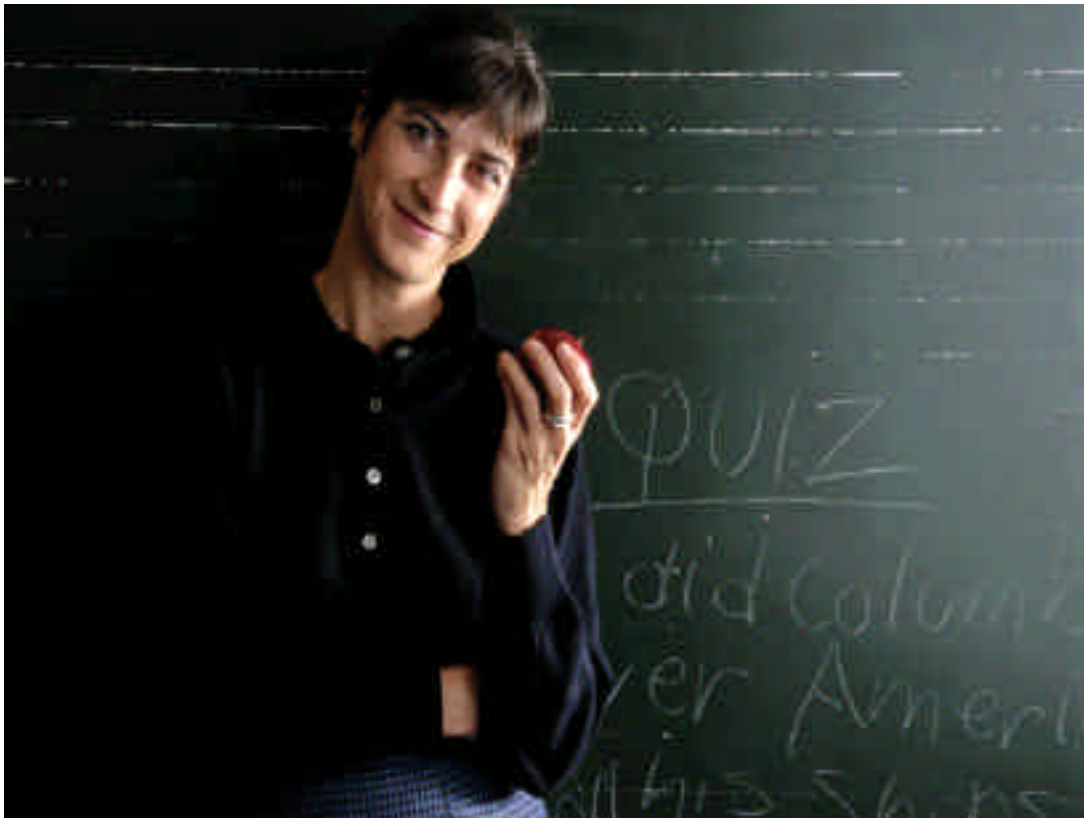

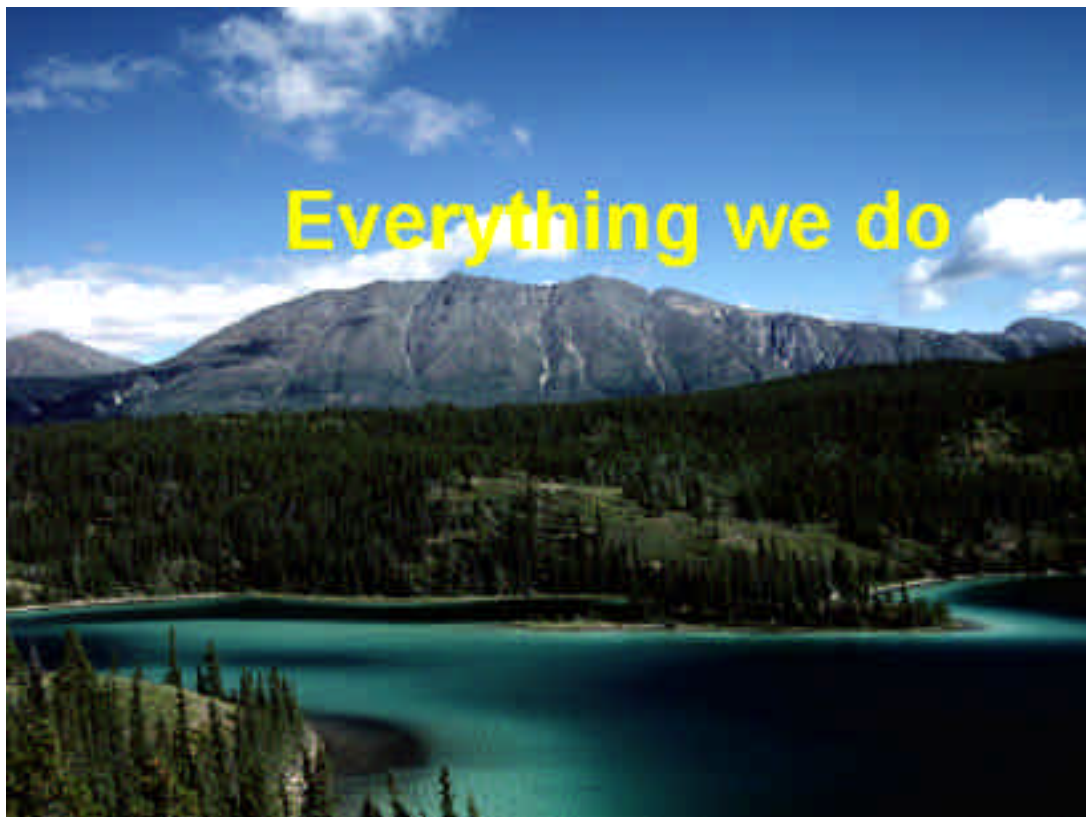
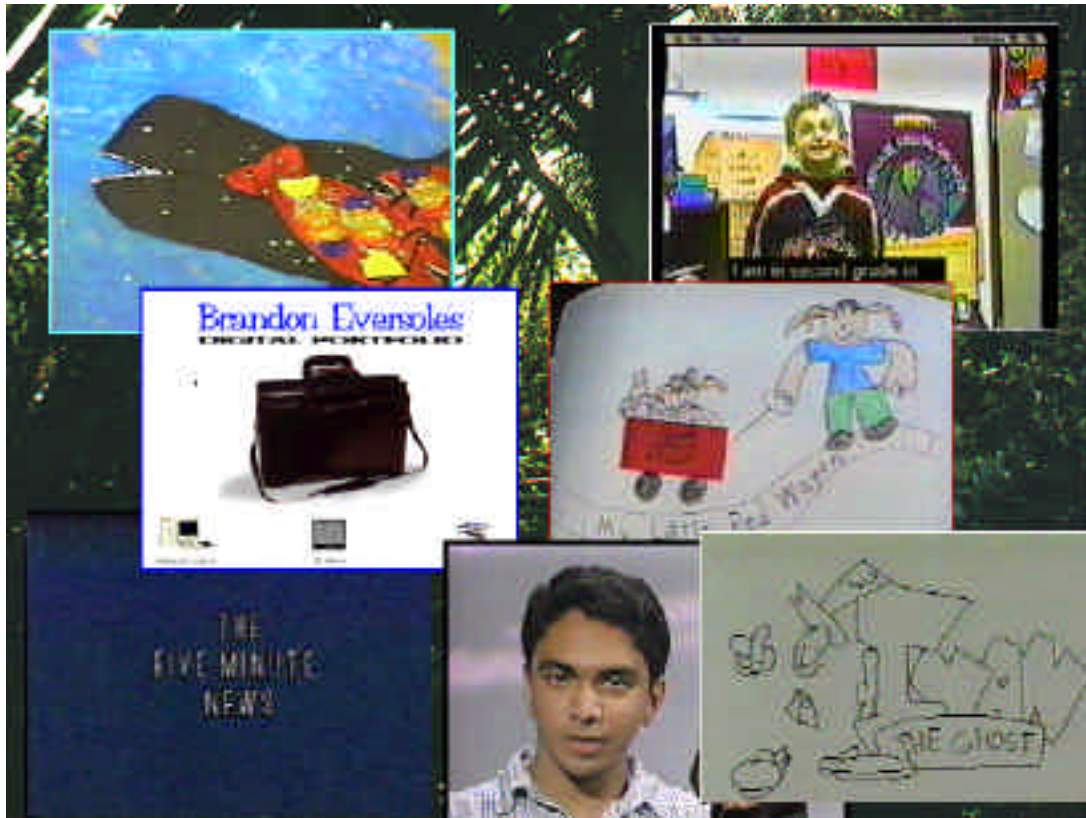
